Also includes Royal Marine close support armour (Centaurs) on some beaches; Tank formations - mostly Shermans including Duplex-Drive (DD) amphibious Shermans with the assault forces; Infantry formations - of battalion size unless otherwise stated; Artillery Regiments - self-propelled and towed artillery. Higher echelon command formations are provided in brackets ().
